## **Public Comment Procedures**

During the public comment portion of the meeting, MACS parents and community members are welcome to make formal comments to the Board, including comments with potentially unpopular or difficult ideas or feedback. The Board's standard procedures for public comments will be followed.

Expressions of support or disagreement (applause, etc.) and outbursts of any kind during the meeting are disruptive and will not be permitted. Thank you for your cooperation.

Public comments are accepted in two ways:

- a. Written comments can be submitted directly to the Board at info@macsnh.org
- b. Verbal comments can be made in person at Board meetings during the designated time for public comments.

The following procedures pertain to public participation at Board meetings:

- Comments (either verbal or written comments submitted in advance) are limited to up to 3 minutes per speaker.
- An individual desiring to speak shall give his/her name, address, and the group, if any, that is represented.
- The Board will not hear personal complaints against any particular school staff member or person connected with the school in the public comment portion of a Board meeting.
