Response to COVID-19 August 2022

Intent:

Based on updated [NH DHHS](#) and [CDC guidance](#), this document outlines the school's response to COVID-19. This new guidance replaces any previous COVID-19 Framework Reopening Policies.

The school will continue to monitor and follow guidance from the CDC, NH Public Health, and local health officials.

August 2022 COVID Framework Policy Update, replacing all previous policy documents:

MACS will conduct teaching and learning in a full in-person model. There are no longer any remote learning options.

Masks are optional, unless a student or staff member is within 10 days of testing positive for COVID-19 (see below).

Any staff or student exhibiting [symptoms of COVID-19](#) should stay home and pursue testing.

Any positive COVID-19 case among staff or students should be reported to the school nurse or school administration.

There will no longer be a quarantine requirement for students or staff *exposed* to COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status. Students or staff who *test positive* for COVID-19 should continue to follow CDC guidelines to stay home for 5 days and wear a well-fitting mask for the following 5 days.
