Job Description

MACS is seeking a specialist teacher to teach Reading and Math in a unique K-8 MicroSociety themed charter school. MACS currently has 300 students and is in the middle of an expansion, and we are looking to fill this position full time. Position details:

- Supports primary teachers in the appropriate identification of students needing intervention
- Provides one-on-one and small group instruction to students needing intervention
- Plans and uses appropriate, research-based instructional and learning strategies, activities, materials and equipment that reflect understanding of the learning styles and needs of identified students
- Uses assessment data to drive instructional decisions on a daily basis
- Develops and implements daily lesson plans and small group activities, consistent with NH State standards and current research methodology
- Provides students with specific evaluative feedback
- Communicates effectively with students, teachers, and parents
- Organizes the educational setting effectively including non-instructional aspects of the classroom
- Working with some ELL (English Language Learner) students is included in position

Qualifications:

- A minimum of a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university within respective specialty curricula field preferred. (Special Education, Elementary Education and/or ELL)
- New Hampshire teacher certification, or evidence of eligibility or progress toward teacher certification, is desired but not required
- Previous experience teaching or working with K-8 students is preferred
- Experience at differentiating instruction, especially for students with a wide range of abilities
- Willingness to commit to the success of MACS's students, and to MACS's mission, and collaborate with faculty as a member of a dynamic instructional team
- Keep administration updated regularly on their needs in order to maximize student achievement
- Candidate agrees to submit to a Criminal Background Records and Fingerprinting Check and a physical
